b) How will the research be done?

Indicate the general approach that would be taken to answer your research questions: identify methods and research plan

c) Why is the research important and how does the research support WorkSafeBC's and/or its partners' mandate?

How is your project innovative, novel and appropriate for an IAW grant? Identify the relevance of your project and state the significance of your project for BC or partner workplaces.

d) How will we know if the research has been successful in solving the problem?

*(In answering this question, please identify the indicators that will assist WorkSafeBC in determining whether the research has been successful in solving the problem.)*

What is the expected impact of your project in the workplace? Who will benefit? Describe outcomes - - tangible measures of success that both you and WorkSafeBC can use during and after project completion.
